### **What is MN Reconnect?**

MN Reconnect is a program that we've partnered with that's designed specifically for returning Minnesota adult learners, 25 and older, who completed 15 or more college credits without finishing, and are ready to complete a certificate, diploma or associate degree within two years.

Whether you're just a few credits away or still in the beginning of your academic journey, MN Reconnect will help you achieve your academic goals and make sure you have the resources for a successful experience.

### **How does MN Reconnect help you complete your desired program?**

Their approach is simple: they meet you where you left off, reconnect you with your program, and help you get back on your path to graduation by providing you with specialized advising that'll help you take advantage of the multiple resources available to adult learners, including everything from state and federal grants to childcare services.

They also provide scholarships of \$1,000 per semester to help you pay for college costs, and up to \$1,000 to release financial holds that prevent re-enrollment.

- 2+2 programs in Elementary Education, Human Services, and Nursing programs
